Due to recent COVID guideline updates by both national and local authorities, we will be making a few changes here at HPC. As announced Sunday, we have been prayerfully discussing next steps as we move forward in caring for you all regarding COVID protocols. With all of the guidelines out there right now, we want you to know that we are doing our best to move forward while still being mindful of those who are more vulnerable.

Starting this Sunday, May 23rd, face coverings will be optional in ALL classes, nursery through adults, and in our worship service. With this change, there will still be protocols in place as listed below. We ask that you please show an abundance of patience and love to one another as we all navigate these changes.

1. You are encouraged to be thoughtful regarding social distancing. There will be those of our family who are not comfortable with hugs, handshakes, or close contact. If you are not sure; it is always wise to ask.
2. No portion of the building will be off limits. However, if you need to utilize any rooms for meetings, classes, etc. other than the set times for Sunday mornings, please notify the office. We want to ensure that the building is thoroughly cleaned after use.
3. Please continue to bring communion for you and your family. The pre-packaged communion in the foyer is for those who forget or for those who are unable to provide their own.
4. Bottled water will continue to be provided on the table by the fountains.
5. Temperature checks will continue for Nursery-K3 for anyone that goes back to that area.
6. We ask that you please let our office know if you test positive for COVID as we will need to let those know who were in close proximity.
7. HPC will continue to have services streaming online for those who do not feel comfortable attending in person or for those who are not feeling well.
